

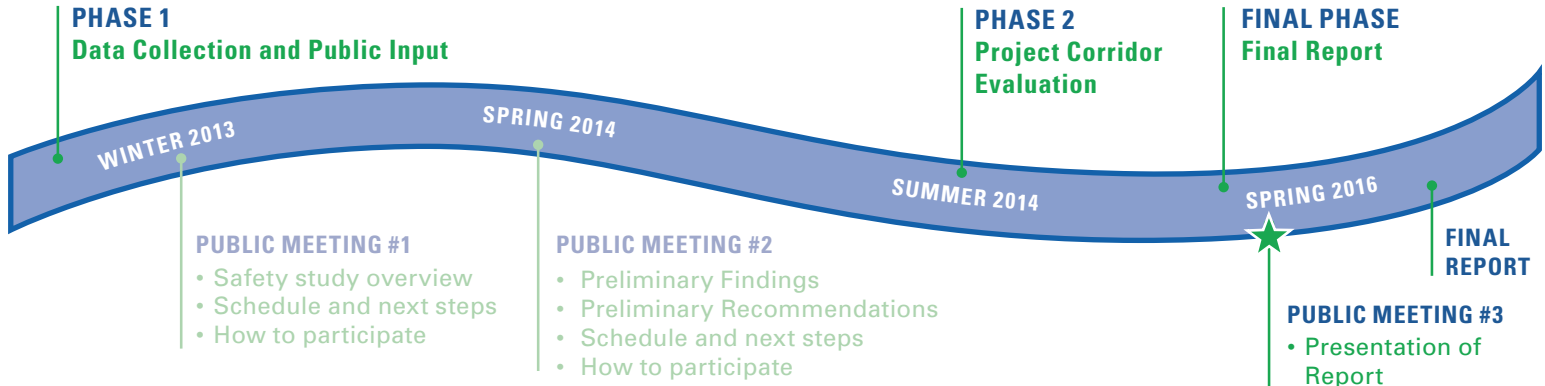
CROW CANYON ROAD

SAFETY STUDY

The Alameda County Public Works Agency has conducted a safety study to evaluate traffic safety concerns on Crow Canyon Road. The purpose of the study was to evaluate and prioritize safety needs based on several factors including traffic data, accident history, roadway features, and public concerns and identify near/mid/long term countermeasures to address safety needs along Crow Canyon Road.

Based on all of the information and public input gathered to date, the Public Works Agency has published a draft final report which is available online. Report findings and recommendations will be presented at the June 2, 2016 meeting.
