### East Bay Greenway Project

#### Notice of Availability of Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration

**WHAT'S HAPPENING:** The Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) is proposing to construct a 12-mile long, Class I Multi-Use Path, Class II Bike Lanes, and Class III Bike Routes from 19th Avenue in Oakland to the Hayward Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) Station. The project would also construct pedestrian facilities along one project roadway segment (Segment 10) that is currently lacking those facilities.

**WHY THIS NOTICE:** This notice is to inform you that the Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration is available on the Alameda CTC website for a 30-day public review period.
